

COACHES', OFFICIALS' AND VOLUNTEERS' CODE OF CONDUCT APPENDIX 1

Cambusdoon Football Club has adopted the code of conduct as introduced by the Scottish Football Association.

- 1. Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- 2. Encourage participation but don't force it.
- 3. Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- 4. Never ridicule mistakes or losses you are there to support not downgrade.
- 5. Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, match officials and spectators.
- 6. Recognise all volunteers are giving up their valuable time, support and encourage them all.
- 7. Don't use offensive remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability
- 8. Consider the safety and well being of participants before performance
- 9. Follow the guidance laid down by the Scottish Football Association and Cambusdoon Football Club
- 10. Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and pursue fair play at all times.
- 11. You must report any issues relating to child protection or welfare to the club Child Protection Officer in a timely manner.
- 12. Prohibit the use of camcorders and cameras unless parental consent has been provided
- 13. Be aware of the Cambusdoon Football Club's Child Protection and Health and Safety Procedures
- 14. Develop an appropriate working relationship with coaches, members, players and volunteers based on mutual trust and respect
- 15. Encourage players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- 16. Must consistently display high standards of appearance, behaviour, honesty and sportsmanship.
- 17. Know where to find appropriate first-aid
- 18. Promote ethical principles and follow the clubs guiding principles of fun, safe and inclusive football.
- 19. Do not do anything likely to bring the name of the Club into disrepute
- 20. Refrain from the consumption of alcohol whilst on official club duty.
