

PARENTS' AND SUPPORTERS' CODE OF CONDUCT APPENDIX 3

Cambusdoon Football Club has adopted the code of conduct as introduced by the Scottish Football Association

1. All parents / guardians must endeavour to protect their children from harm or the risk of harm

- 2. Parents will be responsible for ensuring that their child gets to the match or activity in plenty of time. You will also be responsible for getting your child home safely.
- 3. You must respect every player on the park including the opposition.
- 4. You should avoid coaching your child.

5. You should applaud good play from both sides and teach young people that honest effort is as important as victory

6. You should not shout and scream from the touchline. This isn't professional football!

7. You should not question the match official's decisions/honesty. If adults are seen to question decisions how then are we to get the children to accept decisions?

- 8. You should support and encourage all coaches.
- 9. Encourage your child to play by the laws of the game.
- 10. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from all levels of youth sport
- 11. Do not ridicule or shout at your child, or any other for making a mistake or losing.
- 12. Do not question the coaches' decision during Match or Training time.
- 13. Do not over celebrate goals.
- 14. Do not instruct players during the game.
- 15. Do not force an unwilling youngster to participate.

16. All parents/guardians must complete all necessary Club/SFA registration documents to allow your child to participate

17. All parents / guardians will have access to the Club Child Protection Officer.

18. Only parents / guardians who are officials of the Club will have regular and/or unsupervised contact with the players

19. To follow the Club policies and procedures when on official Club trips
