



PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

APPENDIX 2

Cambusdoon Football Club has adopted the code of conduct as introduced by the Scottish Football Association

1. Play by the rules – the rules of the Club and the laws of the game.
2. Never argue with or abuse a match official. Respect their decision even if you disagree with it.
3. Be a team player – It's a team game, treat it that way.
4. Treat all players (team mates and opposition) as you would like to be treated – fairly and with respect.
5. Co-operate with your coach, the match officials and team-mates.
6. Play for your own enjoyment and to improve your skills.
7. Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability.
8. Respect the Club's property i.e. kit, training facilities, dressing rooms.
9. Ensure that you are punctual for all matches and training sessions.
10. Advise your coach when you will not be available.
11. Inform your coach of any medical condition or injury sustained before or during Club activities.
12. Show a high standard of behaviour during all Club activities and refrain from displaying dissent or bad language.
13. Reply promptly to all letters, electronic communication and telephone calls.
14. Be attentive and enthusiastic. Ask if you do not understand.
15. Prepare yourself correctly for games and coaching sessions. Eat sensibly and get plenty of rest. Alcohol, smoking and drugs will all adversely affect your performance.
16. After the game, shake hands with opposition and match officials.
17. Enjoy yourself. Always put in your best effort.
18. Do not do anything likely to bring the name of the Club into disrepute
19. Abide by the Cambusdoon Football Club Social Media policy. Don't post anything you wouldn't say to someone's face.
